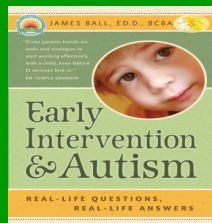


Behavior, Social Skills and Autism

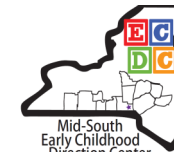

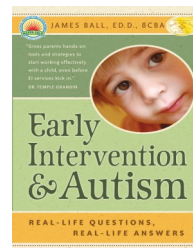

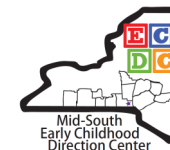
